Your student has expressed interest in becoming a WEB Leader at Winfield Middle School for the 2022-2023 school year. - First Day of School: August 24th, 7 am- 11:20. Students will come early on the first day of school to help run 6th grade Orientation with a group of sixth graders, before their 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes begin.

- Additional social activities, throughout school year (during normal school hours)
