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Three-Month Schedule

March

- Process submittals and procure material orders.
- Classroom and staff relocations to clear out Area 1 area for construction to start.
- Granger to mobilize on-site and set-up construction office.
- Temporary construction barriers to be installed during spring break for Area 1.
- Removal of asbestos floor tile in Area 1 to allow construction activities to start.
- Mechanical and electrical field investigation work to get started.

April

- Phase 1 construction activities to start with work being conducted on 2nd shift.
- Demolition work including flooring, ceilings, corridor walls, mechanical and electrical to be completed.
- Masonry work to get started for the new corridor walls.
- Mechanical and electrical rough-in to get started.

May

- Continue with Phase 1 construction activities on 2nd shift.
- Masonry work to continue for the new corridor walls.
- Continue with mechanical and electrical rough-ins.
- Start demolition in area highlighted in red on 5/30.
- Finalize plan for starting construction in Areas 2-5 on June 10^{th} .





Project Phasing Schedule

- **2020:** Series 1 Design and bidding process, break ground on construction, sitework and start foundations for new Early Childhood Development Center.
- **2021:** Construction of new Early Childhood Center with a November substantial completion. Design and bidding process for Series 2 construction.
- **2022:** Owen renovation complete. IT upgrades.
- 2023: Design and bidding process for Series 3.
- 2024: Edgemont, Rawsonville, Tyler and Savage renovation complete. McBride renovation complete. High school band bleachers for football field. IT upgrades
