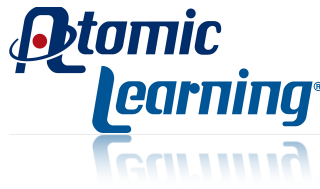


District Employee Laptops

- 1.Login with email and AD password.
- 2.Click OneDrive in top right corner
- 3.Click Office365 in top left corner
- 4.Click Picture of PC & Mac
- 5.Click Install button

Microsoft will allow up to 5 installs of the current version of Office per user while their AD account is active with the district. Once their account is no longer active, the installs will become deactivated.

The Home Use Program (HUP) below is for staff only and is a permanent license and will never deactivate. The license is for whichever version is the current version at that time. You are allowed one purchase in a years' time. You will need this program code to purchase from the HUP program: 37CD0831FA. HUP link:
