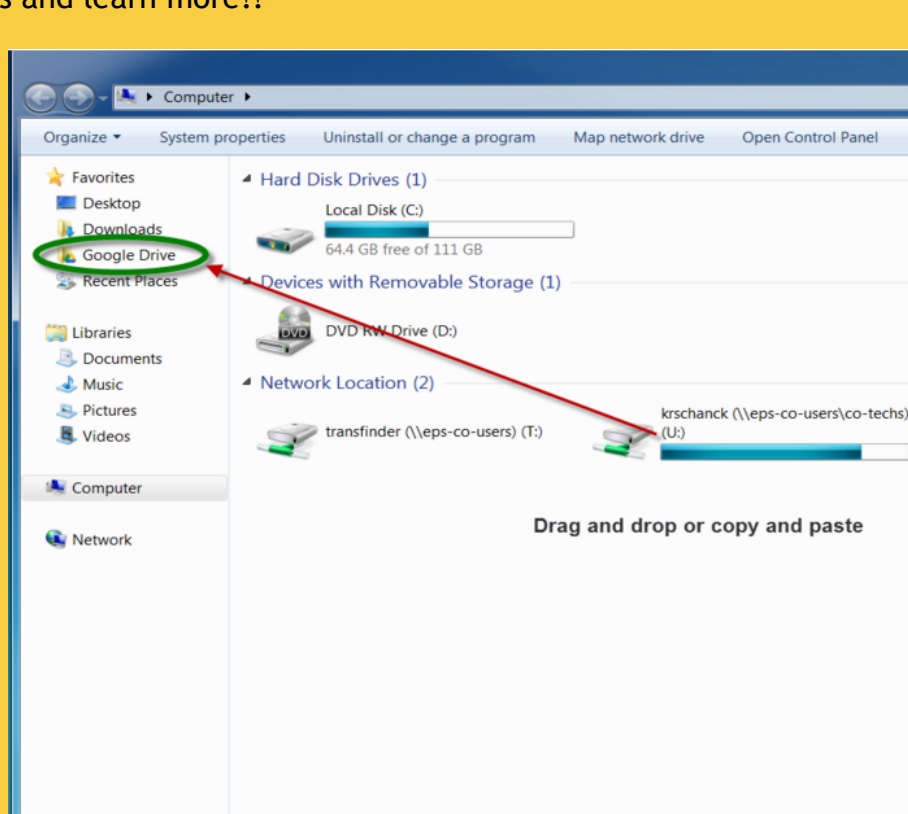




Moving from U: to Google Drive

Here are few Google Extensions that you might find helpful.

CraftyLevel shows you the Flesch-Kincaid reading level of any web page.

Install it, browse to any web page, and see the grade level as a number on the icon in the upper right of the screen.



CraftyRights forces all searches for images to return images that are free to use or share, potentially mitigating copyright concerns. While they make no guarantees, this extension may help avoid copyrighted images.



CraftyText is a simple extension with one purpose; to display text large in the center of the screen. Use it to show your class single words, class codes, or website addresses.
