New Design and New Location for EPS BADGES



Employee badges will now be made at the Technology Service Center located north of the Administrative Service Center at 500 S. Independence. New Employees, badges that are not working properly or employees who have lost their badges are eligible to get a new badge at this time. New employees must have the required Talent Ed items completed and already be in our Active Directory system (have an email address) to get the badge. The badge no longer requires a separate FOB. It has a chip incorporated to activate both doors and printers. The District will provide the first badge free of charge, and if a replacement is necessary, a \$10 fee will be assessed.
