

Tier 3 Interventions

Individual Problem Solving Team will review progress after

6-9 weeks

If student's progress monitoring data indicates steady progress approaching the aim line, is above the 10% on national norms, and rate of improvement is average or approaching average **move to Tier 2 and discontinue Individual Problem Solving**

If student's progress monitoring data indicates steady progress, **continue Tier 3 interventions** for another 6-9 weeks. Continue progress monitoring weekly. Increase goal if appropriate.

If student's progress monitoring data indicates three consecutive data points below the aim line, then **change the Tier 3 intervention** by altering duration, frequency, size of group, grouping and/or program. Continue for another 6-9 weeks.

If progress monitoring data continues to be below the aim line but the student is making consistent progress **continue Tier 3 interventions** and progress monitor for another 6-9 weeks.

If progress monitoring data is below the 10% on national norms, the rate of improvement is below average, there is an achievement gap of 2.0 or greater, there has been at least one change of intervention, and interventions have been implemented with fidelity, **change the Tier 3 intervention**. Continue individual problem solving, intervention plan, and weekly progress monitoring.

If progress monitoring data is below the 10% on national norms, the rate of improvement is below average, there is an achievement gap of 2.0 or greater, there has been at least one change of intervention, and interventions have been implemented with fidelity, **change the Tier 3 intervention or initiate a referral to special education**. Continue individual problem solving and intervention plan until evaluation is complete.
