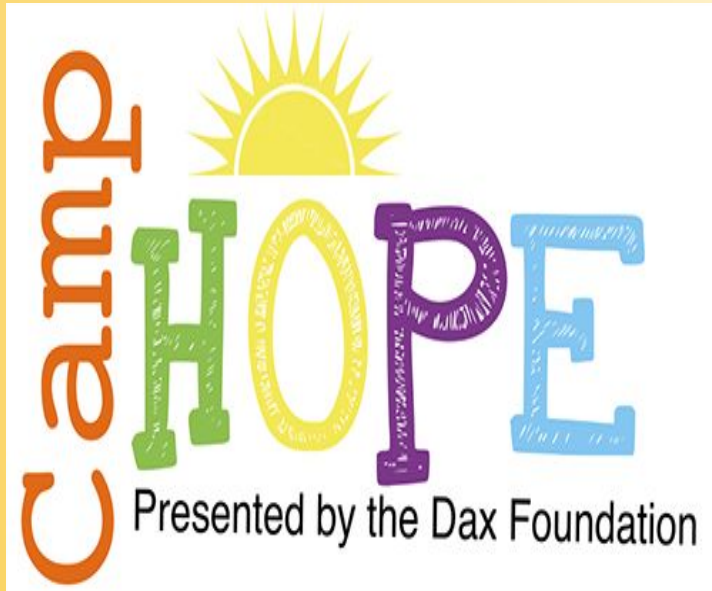
- ❖ The State of Illinois requires all graduates to take the SAT.

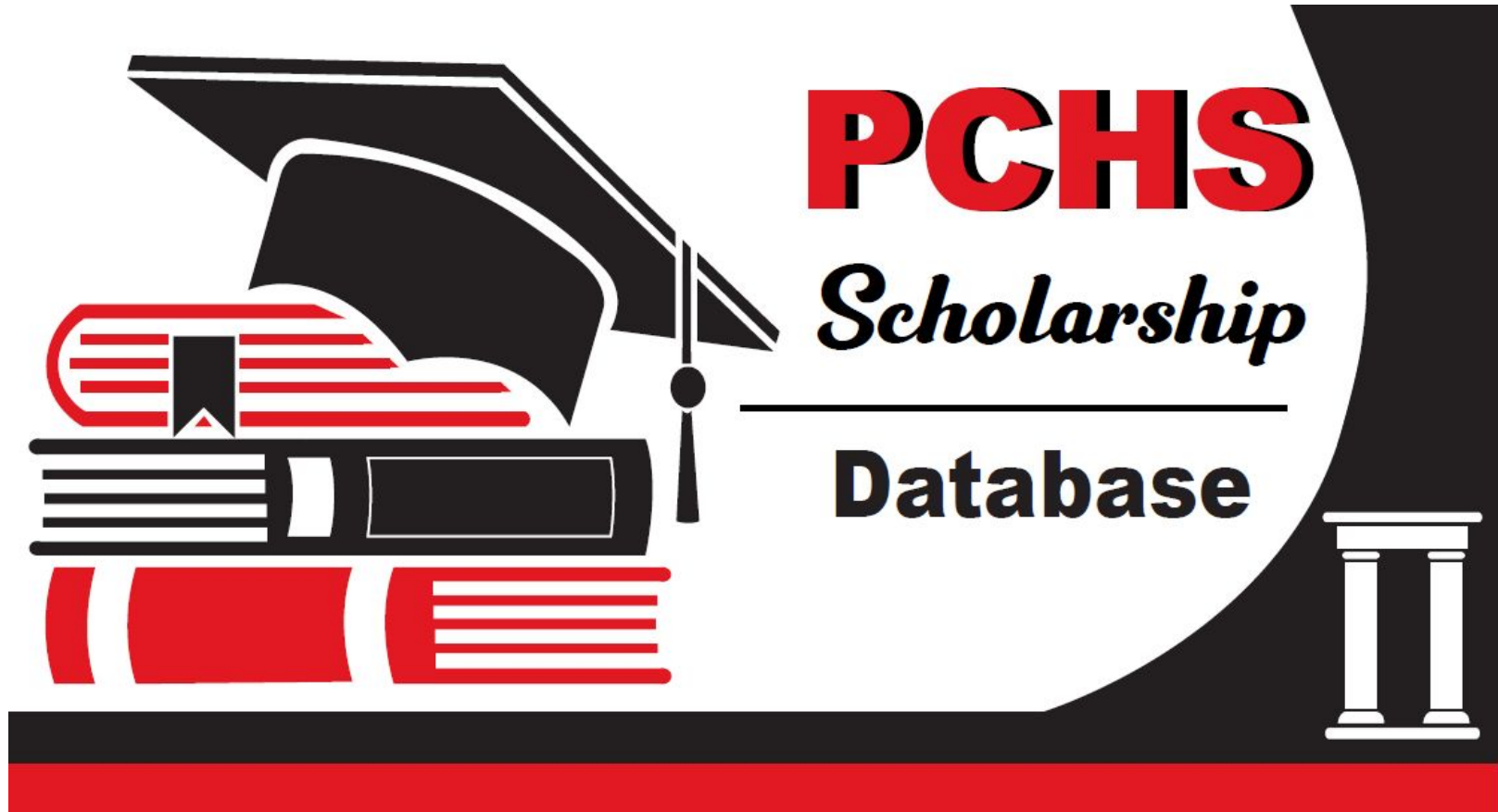
