Dear Westfall Community,

At Westfall, we have finished our first week of school. We are hopeful of having a more typical school year. We are dedicated to giving our students “the best version of ourselves.”

I want to give the community an update on our construction project. Last spring, I told you that the project would begin in August. Throughout the end of August, you will notice preparation for the construction site. I am anxious to witness the beginning of the project. I hope that you are as well!

The focus in the coming weeks is to complete the early sitework package. This involves preparing the site for the coming construction. After the early sitework is completed, there will be a lull in the construction as we await the arrival of our steel. The steel should arrive in February, and the actual construction of the 62,000 square feet addition will proceed.

We are hoping for a completion date in December of 2022. It is important for you to understand that the first priority will be the addition. The completion of some parts of the addition will offer swing space to begin the renovation of the middle and high schools. Much of that renovation will take place next summer. Renovations include new ceilings, lighting, windows, doors, and installation of the new HVAC system.

We have received inquiries about when air conditioning will be installed. With the new addition between our existing high and middle schools, the air conditioning will be installed when a complete system can be interfaced between all three buildings.

There are always some growing pains as a school district goes through a construction project. We are prepared to face those challenges and look forward to an excellent finished project that will serve our community for years to come!

Excavating has begun to start clearing the land of the vegetation in the site, which involves the removal of trees, roots, stumps, bushes, or any other form of vegetation that may hinder the construction process.



The black silt fencing around the perimeter helps to contain dust, debris, and sediment. The construction silt fencing will successfully keep sediment from exiting the job site and from impacting the nearby watershed.

Job site safety is our top priority during this construction project. In addition to protecting workers from potential hazards, a chain link fence has been installed to ensure the public is not exposed to risks.

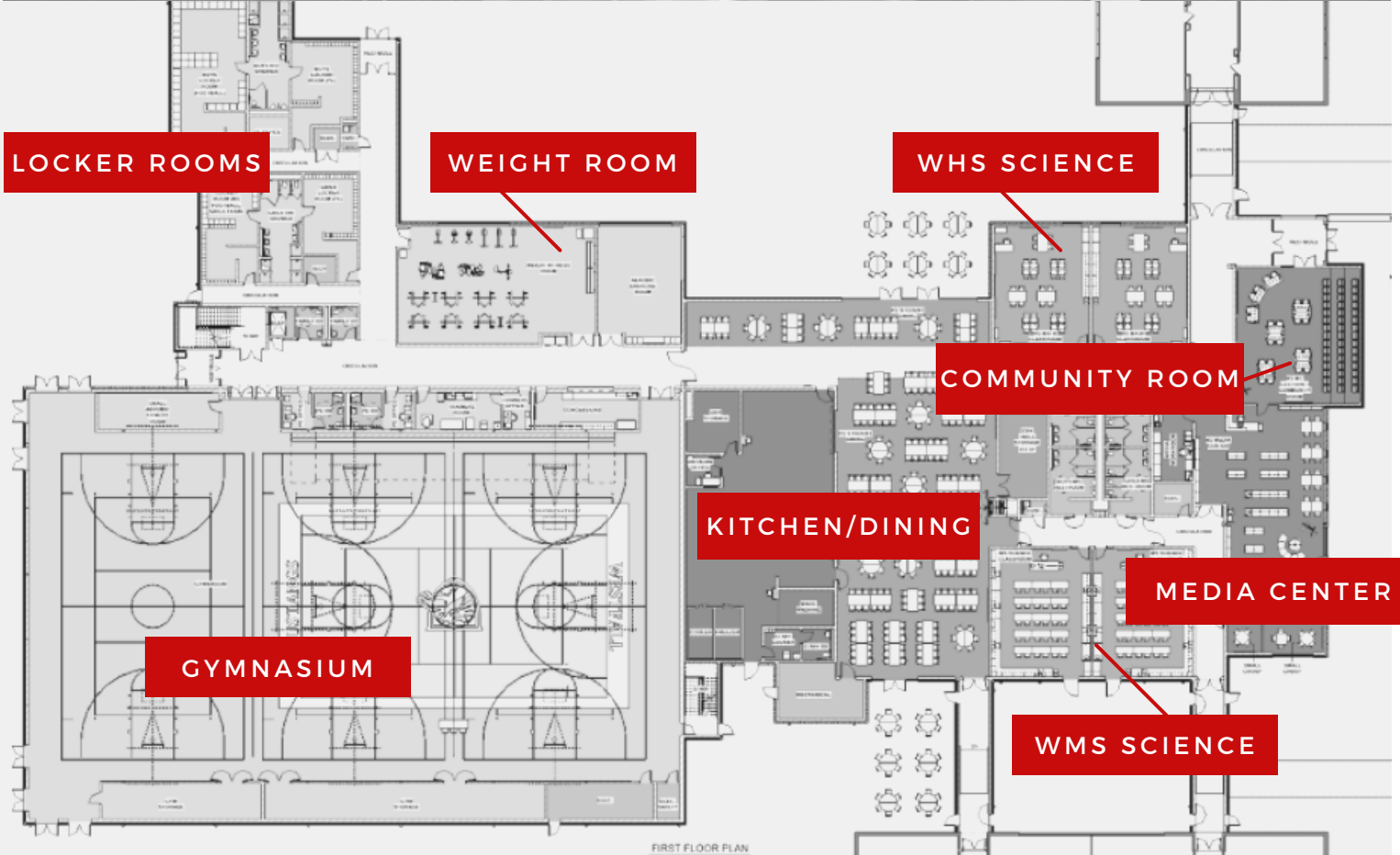


OVERALL PLAN

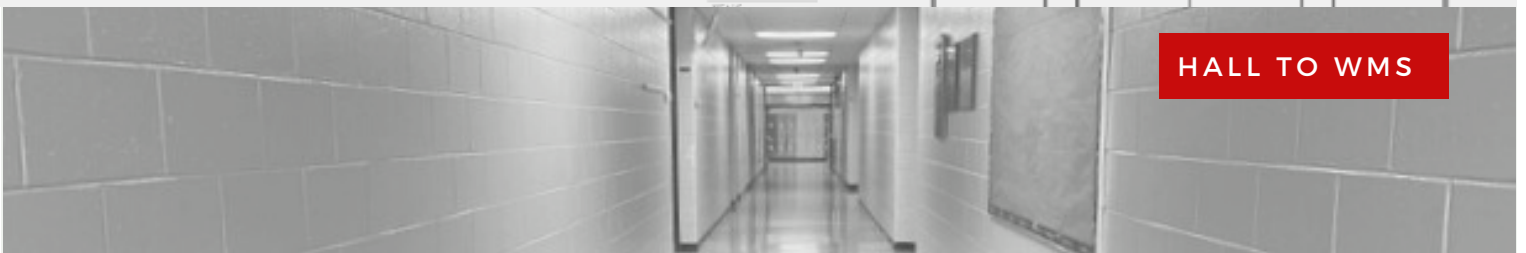

IN ADDITION TO THE FOLLOWING AREAS, THE BUILDING WILL INCLUDE TWO MIDDLE SCHOOL SCIENCE LABS, TWO HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE LABS, A NEW KITCHEN, WEIGHT ROOM, LOCKER ROOMS AND CONCESSIONS

COMMUNITY ROOM

The 1,258 square foot community room will serve as a formal meeting space, well suited for lectures, conferences, film screenings, trade fairs, receptions, and any other event that benefits from this flexible space.



MEDIA CENTER

The 1,716 square foot high school media center will feature upgraded technology, modular furniture to allow for multiple and comfortable seating and room arrangements, and an overall learning environment that is more welcoming and attractive.



STUDENT DINING

The student dining area will boast over 5,000 square feet of multi-purpose space, which includes indoor and outdoor dining capacity enabling a more flexible dining schedule for our Middle and High School students.



ATHLETIC FACILITY

The 30,000 square foot athletic facility will house three full-size basketball courts which mirror the court in our famous high school dome plus a mezzanine walking track on the second level.
