

Good Afternoon,

Our primary milk vendor H.P. Hood has experienced a significant cyberattack that has shut down all operations within their company. As Hood is by far the largest producer of milk in 8 oz packaging in New England, this attack will affect the majority of school nutrition programs throughout New England.

We are currently working with all of our vendors to source other milk products and substitutes. While some milk supply will be available from other dairies, we expect the majority of meals to be offered with 100% juice and/or 8 oz waters as a substitute for the milk component. These substitutions will fall under the USDA waiver issued at the beginning of this year, allowing for meal components to be substituted due to supply shortages. Fresh Picks Café will maintain all necessary documentation to justify this substitution.

Our contacts at Hood expect significant challenges in their ordering and delivery processes throughout the next week as they work to recover from this attack.

We will provide updates as we receive more information. Thank you for your patience as we work with our vendors to mitigate the impact of this situation.
