Dear Parents/Guardians:

Families at all 5 School District 145 buildings can receive Spring/Summer clothing through our local Community Closet. The Community Closet is an organization that provides new and gently used clothing for free to families residing in our school district.

**Families will now have the option, by appointment only to pick out their own clothing at the Community Closet building on the Waverly Intermediate School campus.** If transportation is an issue or you would rather have the clothing delivered to your child's school that option is still available, which will be explained to you when the Community Closet organizer calls to set up your appointment. Appointments will start in April 2022.

The School District 145 Foundation for Education Viking Support Fund partnered with the Community Closet to enhance clothing donations and meet your home needs. The Foundation has obtained items such as home goods including bedding, kitchen appliances, kitchen tools and gadgets, hygiene items, personal items, shoes, etc. to support community need. These items will be distributed for free. You will be able to personally pick out items from the Viking Support Station.

If you have already received clothing from the Community Closet or items from the Viking Support Station in the past you are welcome to receive again. Nobody will be denied.
