## **TPCA App**


We are happy to announce our new TPCA App is now available for free on Google Play or Apple App Store.

## Don't miss any updates from Twin Peaks!

- 1. Search 'Twin Peaks Classical Academy' in your phone's app store and download the app
- 2. Select 'ALLOW' when prompted on initial download to ensure you receive notifications
- 3. Open the app, and navigate to the bottom menu then tap 'SETTINGS'
- 4. Ensure your settings are turned on and your organization is selected



The TPCA App has most of the website features, but its most important function is communication. Anyone who has the App can choose push notifications from:

- Twin Peaks Classical Academy (general all school information)
- From the Director Joe Mehsling
- Elementary School Amber Coniff
- Middle School Alycia Burns
- High School David Yu
- Preschool Leslie Chrysler
- Athletics Cameron Wright

Each user can choose which push notifications they will receive, depending on the grade level(s) of your student(s). However, we recommend that everyone chooses *Twin Peaks Classical Academy* and *From the Director* as these will provide you with "whole school" information.

Regardless of what push notifications a user chooses, all messages will go to the Live Feed on our website.

The intent of the TPCA App is to provide messages in a shorter format, more often, and targeted to each user's needs.

The calendar feature is much cleaner than the website too!


