To view this you will access the Parent Portal account with Infinite Campus, West Valley's student information system. If you do not already have an account, please call the office (406) 755-7239 and they will set one up for you. This is the same system that you will use for re-enrollment for the next school year. Your student also has access to this system if you would like them to share their grades with you. If you require a printed version of the report, please contact the school. Through this app, I am able to receive updates in real time for both attendance and grades.

Clothing Requirements

In the interest of an effective educational environment, fulfilling federal and state mandates, and the promotion of healthy attitudes West Valley School has developed the following expectations:

- Students must wear shoes.
- Tops/bottoms must be worn.
- No bare waists/backs/shoulders. (belly shirts, crop tops)
- Tank tops, straps less than 2" wide or large armholes allowed.
- Shorts, skirts and dresses must be mid-thigh length or longer.
- "Ripped" style jeans and shorts must not have holes above the mid-thigh.
- Pajamas (tops or bottoms) and costumes are not permitted.

- Hats, caps, or other types of head covering worn inside the school building are prohibited unless special circumstances dictate otherwise.
- Undergarments should not be visible at any time.
- Clothing that promotes or symbolizes alcohol/drug use, tobacco slogans, violence, sexism, racism, sexual behavior, or profanity will not be permitted at school or school sponsored functions.
