## Immunization/Health Reminders

#### **Dear Parents/Guardians**

The WV Department of Education and the WV Department of Health and Human Resources Bureau for Public Health have updated school entry requirements to minimize health barriers to attendance and learning. They follow current recommendations from the US Center for Disease Control (CDC).

### All students entering 0k grade in Fall 2022:

- Must have completed all 0k vaccinations (Tdap, MMR, Varicella, Hep B, Polio)
- Turn in copy/proof of required vaccines to your child's school by August 18th, 2022
- Health Check/ Physical exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Dental exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Turn in documentation of Health Check and dental exam to your child's school prior to the first day of school for students, August 23,2022

# All students entering 2<sup>nd</sup> grade in Fall 2022:

- Health Check/ Physical exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Dental exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Turn in documentation of Health Check and dental exam to your child's school prior to the first day of school for students, August 23, 2022

# All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade in Fall 2022:

- Must have one dose of the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) vaccine
- *Must* have one dose of the MCV (Meningococcal) vaccine
- Turn in copy/proof of required vaccines to your child's school by August 18th, 2022
- Health Check/ Physical exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Dental exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Turn in documentation of Health Check and dental exam to your child's school prior to the first day of school for students, August 23,2022

### All students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade in Fall 2022:

- Must also have had at least one dose of the Tdap vaccine
- **Must** have second dose of the Meningococcal vaccine. (If the first dose of the Meningococcal vaccine was received after the age 16, only one dose of this vaccine is required.)
- Turn in copy/proof of required vaccines to your child's school by August 18, 2022
- Health Check/ Physical exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Dental exam (completed within prior 12 calendar months)
- Turn in documentation of Health Check and dental exam to your child's school prior to the first day of school for students, August 23, 2022
