Our Board met on Wednesday, March 9 and approved the new guidelines set forth by the Governor and the State of California. Starting **Monday, March 14**, you will be able to decide whether your child will wear a mask indoors at school. We will support either decision.

To limit the spread, we will continue our current schedule at school which keeps students in their grade-level pods. Our plan is to do that until we are out of the "Mask Highly Recommended Phase". Our hope is to come out of that phase by the end of April, which will then allow us to end the school year in a more normal fashion and begin the next school year as normal as possible.

As a reminder, we may still need to wear masks on field trips or at other facilities based on what decisions have been made by the people who operate their facilities. We will be good guests under those circumstances and wear masks during those times. We will continue to provide masks for those who want/need them until a time at which we run out of masks.
