

## Limestone Baptist Church's \$500 Senior Scholarship

### Who:

Open to any senior at Superior Central who is planning to continue their education upon graduation. This includes colleges, universities, trade schools, and programs that provide certificates.

### What:

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to one senior, assuming all qualifications are met.

### Process:

Each entrant shall fill out the form and compose an essay that answers the prompt. Turn the essay in to the high school office by Friday, May 13, 2022. Someone will retain the names of the entrants and their forms before sending the anonymous essays to a panel for adjudication, allowing the process to be open to anyone without partiality.

The essays will be judged by a panel according to the rubric provided. Should any member of the graduating class have family members in the church, those people will be excluded from the panel.

### Essay Prompt:

First Corinthians 13, often referred to as "the love chapter" describes the characteristics of someone who embodies genuine love for another person. Look up the passage ([biblegateway.com](http://biblegateway.com) is a good place to find it) and name a person who exhibits these characteristics. Describe how they have influenced those around them with these attributes. (It may be someone who has influenced you personally or others, in history or now.) How did this person's example encourage you to change? How will this influence your life in the future?
