State Assessments Begin

State assessment testing season starts this week. Students in grades 3-8 and 10 take the math and reading assessment, both of which are two 45 to 60 minute sessions. Students in grades 5, 8, and 11 take the science assessment, also two sessions lasting 45 to 60 minutes. Those in grades 4, 7, and 11 will complete a project for the social studies assessment. Teachers have between March 21st through April 29th to complete testing sessions. The majority of teachers will scheduling testing before lunch hours are immediately after. Families can help students prepare by ensuring a good nights rest, breakfast, and helping your child stay hydrated. School attendance during the testing sessions is very important.
