Graduation Walk Requirements

Participation in graduation exercises is a privilege.

- Students **MUST** fulfill all South Summit High School/Utah State graduation requirements before graduation.
- Students must take a minimum of **5** classes, both semesters of their senior year.
- Students must meet Attendance Policy requirements to walk at graduation.
- Students graduating early **must** meet with their counselor and can walk with the first class that walks after completing graduation requirements.

Honors Graduation Requirements

To graduate with Honors from SSHS you need:

*Mathematics	4.0 credits
*Science	4.0 credits
Social Studies	3.0 credits
Fine Arts	1.5 credits
Physical Education	1.0 credit
Fitness for Life	0.5 credit
Health	0.5 credit
Digital Literacy	0.5 credit
Career and Technical Education (CTE)	2.0 credits
*Foreign Language (consecutive) Or AP Foreign Language Class	2.0 credits 1.0 credits
General Financial Literacy	0.5 credit
Elective	8.5 credits
Total	32 credits

It is your responsibility to check with the Counselor to see which courses count for credit towards Honors.

Generally, each high school semester academic class is worth 0.5 credit and college semester classes are worth 1.0 credit each.

Honors Academic Requirements to wear Honors Graduation Cords:

- **Meet Honors SSHS graduation diploma requirement**
- **AND have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 – 4.0**



Department Honors Requirements

(Students APPLY for Honor Cords in their Senior year)

Fine Arts

- 3 Fine Arts credits required
- A- or better required in each course
- You may choose any combination of Fine Arts courses, as long as you meet any prerequisites for upper level courses

Foreign Language

- 3 years of foreign language study (2 of those years must be in the same language)
 - Grade of A- or better in each foreign language course

Language Arts

- The following courses must be completed with the following grade levels or better:
 - English 9 with an A- or English 9 Honors with a B+
 - English 10 with an A- or English 10 Honors with a B+
 - Juniors - AP English with a B, or English 11 with an A-
 - Seniors -- AP English or English 2010 with a B+

Mathematics

- The following courses must be completed with the following grade levels or better:
 - Core Math I with an A- or Core Math I Honors with a B+
 - Core Math II with an A- or Core Math II Honors with a B+
 - Core Math III with an A- or Core Math III Honors with a B+
 - Math 1030, 1040, 1050, AP Calculus or AP Statistics with a B or better

Performing Arts

- Three credits of Performing Arts with an A- or better in each course. Must have taken classes in at least two different subject areas, eg., Choir & Theater, OR
- Four credits of Performing Arts, with an A- or better in each course in the same subject area
- Performing Arts courses include Beginning Dance, Dance Company, Drill, Band, Percussion, Jazz Band, Orchestra, Choir, Tapestry, Guitar, Theater Foundations

Science

- Four credits of science are required.
 - A- or better in each high school course is required
 - B or better is required in any Concurrent Enrollment/Live Interactive/AP science course
- Students need to meet the above requirements in the following manner:
 - Biology/Ag Biology/Biology 1010 (1 credit)
 - Chemistry (1 credit)
 - Physics/AP Physics (1 credit)
 - A fourth elective science (Concurrent Enrollment, Live interactive or CTE Science course)

Social Studies

- 3.5 credits are required with a grade of A- or better
 - Geography
 - World History
 - U.S. Government and Citizenship
 - U.S. History II
 - At least .5 credits of another recognized Social Science, such as AP US History, Economics, Psychology, Political Science 1100, Psychology 1010 or Sociology 1010

Associates Degree

- Students must complete an Associate's Degree through the SSHS/UVU CE/LI program

General Education Requirements certificate:

- Students must complete the Certificate of General Education requirements through the SSHS/UVU CE/LI program
