March 23, 2022

The Greene County Community School District Board of Directors met in special session on March 23, 2022 in the District Board Room, located in the Middle School. President Steve Fisher called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Directors Cindi Daubendiek, Michelle Fields, John McConnell and Bonnie Silbaugh; and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present; As were Lyle Schwartz and Dennis Bahr, Search Consultants with McPherson & Jacobson, LLC.

Fields made and Daubendiek seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Daubendiek made and McConnell seconded a motion to hire the following teachers: Paige Meyer – 4th grade teacher, Conner Mueller – Middle School Science. Motion carried 5-0.

At 5:18 p.m. Daubendiek made and Silbaugh seconded a motion to go into closed session as provided in Iowa Code 21.5(1)(i) of the open meetings law to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose hiring is being considered to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation, as that individual has requested a closed session. Motion carried 5-0.

The board returned to open session at 8:23 p.m. Fields made and McConnell seconded a motion to invite Michael Van Sickle and Brett Abbots to interview for the Superintendent position on March 29 and March 30, 2022. Motion carried 5-0.

Daubendiek made and Silbaugh seconded a motion to approve the timetable for the interview days as presented. Motion carried 5-0. The candidates will arrive in the District Office at 8:15 on their designated day. They will tour the District Buildings, meet with stakeholder groups: administration, students, support staff, teachers and community representatives throughout the day. The Board will interview each candidate at 7:15 p.m., in closed session.
