Dear Kindergarten Parents/Guardians,

To ensure our students have a healthy start, there are certain Health requirements that must be met before your child starts the school year. Listed below are those requirements. Please return the completed forms before the start of school in August. You can drop them off at the elementary office anytime.

School Physical Exam completed by a physician: Recommended

Preschool physical exam is accepted from last year if current

Up to date immunization record: Required

Boosters are needed after age 5 or before entering Kindergarten. If there are medical reasons or religious beliefs for not receiving immunizations, the appropriate certificate of exemption must be completed.

Vision Screening: Required

The certificate needs to be completed, signed and dated for proof of screening. The vision screening can be performed by your child's medical physician or an eye physician.

Lead Screening: Required

All children entering Kindergarten must have a lead blood screening completed around 6mo-4 years old. Proof of this screening can be obtained from your child's medical physician.

Dental Screening: Required

lowa law requires this between ages 3 years old and Kindergarten enrollment. Your child's dentist needs to complete the exam, sign, and date the dental certificate. PreK I-smile screenings would fill this requirement if your child participated in screening.

Health History: Recommended

We have enclosed the forms needed. Please complete and return to the elementary school office. All forms **MUST BE RETURNED** before your child attends school this fall.
