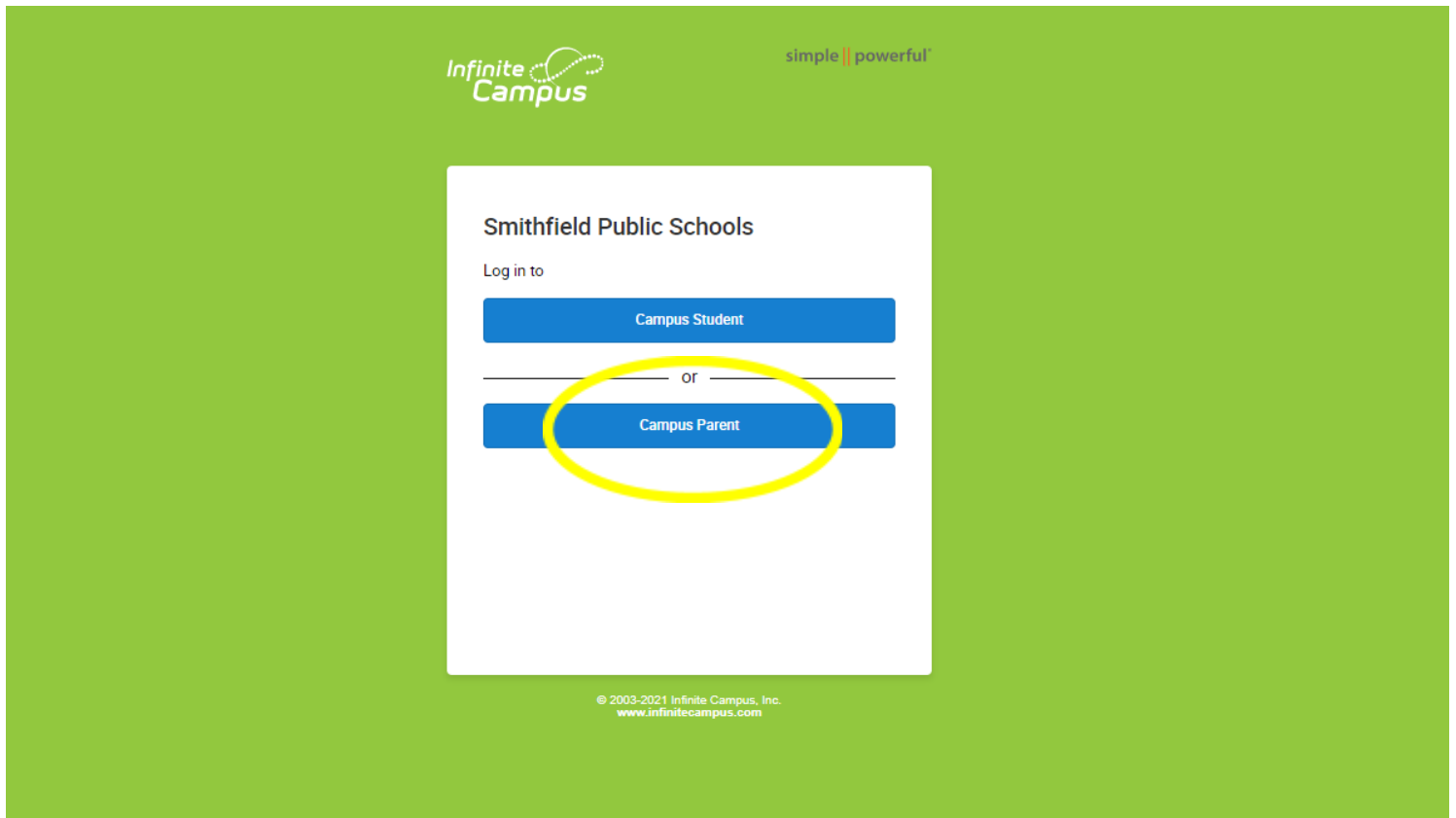


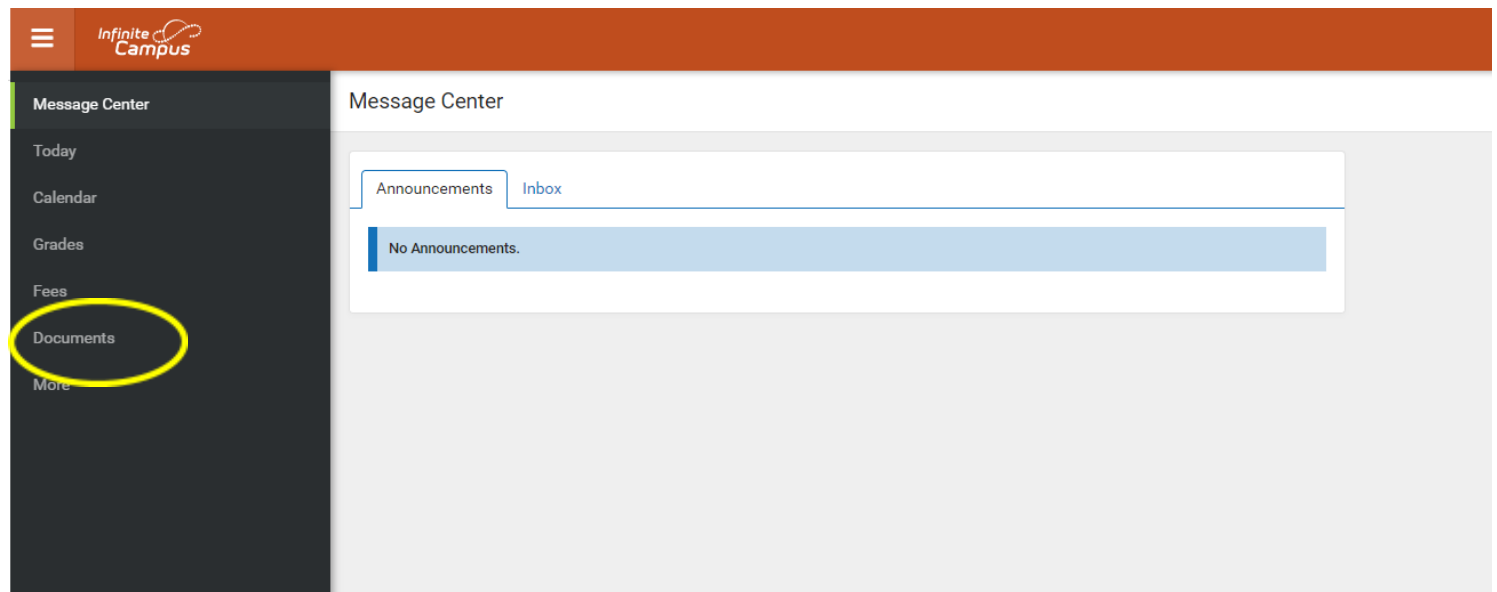
To begin, please sign into Campus Parent Account at:
