- Learn how to use new resources provided by the DOE linked to the new ILEARN state math assessment for 2018-19*
- Learn how to use other classroom-ready math resources aligned to the new ILEARN state math assessment for school year 2018-19*
- Create a new math curriculum map (calendar) based upon the 2014 Indiana Academic Standards with a particular focus on “Super Standards”*
- Work in grade-level teams to create DOK math problems and/or performance tasks at level 3*
- Work in grade-level teams to create bell ringer activities or math problems aligned to the “Super Standards”*
