Dear Students/Parents/Guardians:

The intent of this letter is to inform you of the spring testing schedule and what will be expected of each student on testing days. Students' requirements and expectations are based on their grade level and necessary testing.

Wednesday, April 13, 2022

Seniors will report to RESA or the school to complete their senior interview at their scheduled time. RESA students that have already completed their interview will only need to report to their RESA course. **Seniors will only need to report to school at their interview time.**

Juniors will take the SAT test from 8:00 - 12:30. Students **will be released** after they complete the test. Lunch will be available at the conclusion of the test.

Freshman and Sophomores will take the PSAT test from 8:00 - 11:30 and will eat lunch from 11:30 - 12:15. They will resume regular classes and complete their 5th, 6th, and 7th hours as scheduled.

Accommodated testers will have an individual testing schedule. Your caseload teacher will explain to each student individually what their schedule will be.

All Juniors, Sophomores and Freshmen will need to report to school by 8:00 am. Students arriving after 8:15 will not be allowed to test and will need to attend the make-up session on April 26th for SAT/PSAT or April 28th for ACT Workkeys.

Thursday, April 14, 2022

Seniors will report to RESA, complete a job shadow opportunity, or complete a college visit. Students must turn in their forms to the office for job shadow or college visit prior to the day. **Seniors will not need to report in person to the school.**

Juniors will take the ACT Workkeys test from 8:00 - 12:00. Students **will be released** after they complete the test. Lunch will be available at the conclusion of the test.

Freshman and Sophomores will have a regularly scheduled day.

Accommodated testers will have an individual testing schedule. Your caseload teacher will explain to each student individually what their schedule will be.
