

## **ACADEMIC OFFERINGS**

The Avon School is accredited Level 1 by the South Dakota Division of Elementary and Secondary Education. Avon High School offers courses in english, science, industrial arts, social sciences, computer, mathematics, business education, health/PE and speech. The Avon Elementary School offers a full program of studies as prescribed in the State course of Study, including kindergarten and special education programs, in addition to the regular courses which include: programs in mathematics and reading through Title 1; Speech, Hearing, Language, Psychological services; and an early childhood program are offered through the South Central Education Cooperative of which Avon Public School is a member. Programs are available providing assistance to students with learning disabilities.

#### **Co-Curricular Activities**

High School activities include instrumental music, vocal music, speech, drama, journalism, football, boys and girls basketball, girls volleyball, boys and girls track, boys and girls golf, boys and girls cross country, wrestling and softball. Middle School programs are offered in music and athletics as well.

## **Grades K-12 Registration**

All grades, K-12, will begin school on Wednesday, August 17. Grades K-6 will register in their respective classrooms and grades 7-12 will register in the gym. School begins at 8:10 a.m. and dismisses at 3:25 (grades K-4) and 3:29 (grades 5-12).

## **NEW STUDENTS**

Students who did not attend Avon School last year should register at the Avon School prior to the start of school. New students must register with a certified birth certificate, immunization record and high school transcript (9-12) prior to the first day.

### **PRESCHOOL**

A preschool program is available to 4-5 year old children. It is offered Monday-Thursday from 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Parents must apply to determine enrollment. The cost is \$110 per month per child. PK students will register in their classroom on August 17.

## **BOARD MEETINGS**

The Avon Board of Education meets regularly on the second Monday of each month. These are open meetings held to take care of routine matters and to formulate policies which provide for a good education for students.

We encourage parents to complete the Federal Lunch Application for Free and Reduced-Price Meals prior to the start of school. Applications will be mailed to each household. Applications do not carry over from the previous year. Benefits do not begin until the application has been approved. *Please Note:* students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals must have available funds to purchase a la carte items.

## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION POLICY

The school provides transportation to many school activities and students are expected to ride the bus. Students may ride home with their parents, only if the parent is at the activity and asks the student supervisor for permission to do so. If a student wants to ride to an activity with his/ her parents, a slip should be presented to the Principal or Superintendent prior to the event. A student may ride to or from a school activity with someone else only if an adult (21 or older) is in the vehicle. A transportation permission form must be completed and given to the Principal or the Superintendent no later than 4 p.m. that day if it is an evening activity. For the daytime activities, the form should be returned the day before the activity takes place. Parents are to come to the school or call the school to obtain the transportation permission form. In situations where the school administration feels that it is necessary for students to ride to and from an activity on the bus, permission to ride with someone else will be denied.

## School Closings

Announcements for school cancellations and latestarts due to inclement weather and other causes will be broadcast on local television and radio stations. Announcements will be made by the 7:00 a.m. broadcast or as early as possible thereafter. Announcements will also be generated on the school's automated messenger system. The system will send out phone and email messages to each household.

## **PE CLASS REQUIREMENTS**

All K-12 students are required to have separate PE athletic shoes. NO STREET SHOES are allowed on the gym floor. Please provide a drawstring sports bag for shoe storage.

ALL PARENTS AND VISITORS MUST USE THE SOUTH MAIN ENTRANCE AND ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN IN AND OUT AT THE BUSINESS OFFICE.
