



DEFENSIVE DRIVER TRAINING TEST INSTRUCTIONS

Utah Risk Management requires any employee who drives a district vehicle or uses their own vehicle for school/district business, including transporting students to/from school activities, to complete defensive driver training *every two years*. To access the training and test, you must login (use Google Chrome) to the Utah Learning Portal at (*click the link*):

Utah Learning Portal (ULP):

- Login *or* If you are a first-time user, you must create an account.
 - Security Keyword: **s summit** (be sure to add the space after the "s")

Getting Started:

1. Launch and watch the Defensive Driver Training video.
2. Answer the 25 Question Challenge.
3. After watching the video you will be given your score.
4. Click the "SUBMIT" button.
5. Return to ULP
 - a. Click the "ME" Tab (upper left side)
 - b. Under *Learning and Certifications*, click the green square-*Completed*
 - c. Print your Defensive Driver Training Certificate.
 - d. Save it, scan it and email it to the Transportation Department at kbeckstead@ssummit.org along with a copy of your current Driver's License or bring it to the Bus Garage so we can make a copy for our files.
6. If you did not pass you can watch the video and take the test again.
 - a. Login to ULP, click the ME tab, locate the Defensive Driving Course and click on the arrow next to Print Certificate then select *Retake*.
7. The passing score is 70%.
