

DEFENSIVE DRIVER TRAINING TEST INSTRUCTIONS

Utah Risk Management requires any employee who drives a district vehicle or uses their own vehicle for school/district business, including transporting students to/from school activities, to complete defensive driver training *every two years*. To access the training and test, you must login (use Google Chrome) to the Utah Learning Portal at (*click the link*):

<u>Utah Learning Portal (ULP)</u>:

- Login *or* If you are a first-time user, you must create an account.
 - *Security Keyword*: **s summit** (be sure to add the space after the "s")

Getting Started:

- 1. Launch and watch the Defensive Driver Training video.
- 2. Answer the 25 Question Challenge.
- 3. After watching the video you will be given your score.
- 4. Click the "SUBMIT" button.
- 5. Return to ULP
 - a. Click the "ME" Tab (upper left side)
 - b. Under *Learning and Certifications*, click the green square-*Completed*
 - c. Print your Defensive Driver Training Certificate.
 - d. Save it, scan it and email it to the Transportation Department at kbeckstead@ssummit.org along with a copy of your current Driver's License or bring it to the Bus Garage so we can make a copy for our files.
- 6. If you did not pass you can watch the video and take the test again.
 - a. Login to ULP, click the ME tab, locate the Defensive Driving Course and click on the arrow next to Print Certificate then select *Retake*.
- 7. The passing score is 70%.
