Windsor School District Gifted Education SCREENING CRITERIA

Students being considered for the Gifted Program must have <u>Two</u> of any of the following criteria to move from the screening process to the evaluation process.

Kindergarten

- 1. Ratings of 4 and 5 on all Pathways assessments given during the First Semester.
- 2. Meets expectations in <u>all</u> areas indicated on the Report Card for Second Quarter.
- 3. A cumulative average of 90% or higher on district's grade level math assessments given during the First Semester.
- 4. Score at the 75th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher complete a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the 75th or higher percentile.

1st Grade

- 1. Ratings of 4 and 5 on <u>all</u> Pathways assessments given during the First Semester.
- 2. Meets expectations in all areas indicated on the Report Card for Second Quarter.
- 3. A cumulative average of 90% or higher on district's grade level math assessments given during the First Semester.
- 4. A score on both NWEA assessments at the 95th percentile or higher.
- 5. Score at the 75th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher complete a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the 75th or higher percentile.

2nd Grade

- 1. Ratings of 4 and 5 on all Pathways assessments given during the First Semester.
- 2. Meets expectations in all areas indicated on the Report Card for Second Quarter.
- 3. A cumulative average of 90% or higher on district's grade level math assessments given during the First Semester.
- 4. A score on both NWEA assessments at the 95th percentile or higher.
- 5. Score at the 75th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher complete a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the 75th or higher percentile.

3rd Grade

- 1. A score on two out of the three NWEA assessments at the 95th percentile or higher.
- 2. A cumulative average of 90% or higher in all areas indicated on the Report Card for First Semester.
- 3. Score at the 75th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher completes a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the 75th or higher percentile.

4th –8th Grades

- 1. A score on two out of the three NWEA assessments at the 95th percentile or higher.
- 2. At least one rating at the **Advanced Level** on the most recent MAP test.
- 3. A cumulative average of 90% or higher in all core subject areas indicated on the Report Card for First Semester.
- 4. Score at the **75**th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher completes a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the **75**th or higher percentile.

9th—12th Grades

- 1. A rating at the **Advanced Level** on the most recent MAP/EOC test
- 2. A cumulative average of 90% or higher on all core subjects on the district's grade level assessments given during the First Semester.
- 3. Score at the **75**th or higher percentile on the Teacher Recommendation Form. If more than one teacher completes a Teacher Recommendation Form, that the student must have an <u>average</u> at the **75**th or higher percentile.
