NJSLA & Start Strong

- NJSLA was not administered in Spring of 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The New Jersey Department of Education requires all districts to administer an abbreviated version of NJSLA (Start Strong) during the Fall of 2021
 - 60 minute test in ELA & Math in grades 4th 8th
 - 60 minute test in Science 6th Grade
 - Start Strong examines the student's previous year's knowledge
 - The results will be available shortly after the close of the testing window in October
