Building Steering Committee Report/Recommendation Con't.

Paul Kalmar read a letter that was handed out to the BOE members. The letter gave an overview of what the Steering Committee felt were the greatest needs of the school. Sarah Sipe with Landmark presented to the BOE the layout ideas for the additions needed.

Derek Zongker read the Resolution:

Shall Unified School District No. 310, Reno County, Kansas (Fairfield) (the "District"), issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,895,000, to pay the costs to construct, furnish and equip improvements, renovations and additions to the existing district school building, including (a) updates and upgrades to the safety and security of the campus by securing and controlling all access and entrances of the building with new technology and main entrance vestibule, (b) an eight classroom addition to the elementary wing, with four pre-K and kindergarten classrooms, one of which would be constructed to serve as a storm shelter room, (b) infrastructure improvements, including electrical upgrades throughout the district, (c) roof replacement on the existing elementary wing, (d) a kitchen and cafeteria expansion and renovation, (e) a physical education classroom addition, with a full size court, bleachers, weight room, and locker rooms and restrooms constructed to serve as storm shelter rooms, and (f) all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto; all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*; K.S.A. 25-2018(f); K.S.A. 72-6761; and K.S.A. 75-2315 *et seq.*?

Steven Westfahl and Travis Mathes moved and seconded the approval to adopt the Resolution. Motion carried 7-0.

6. Superintendent's Update:

- a. District Vision. Tabled until September 12, 2016.
- b. <u>Superintendent's Evaluation Tool Selection.</u> Example of tool included in the BOE packet. Steven Westfahl feels the process as a whole needs to be reviewed.
- c. <u>Back to School Update</u>. Bruce Bingham and Jessica Zink are the new teachers that were hired. Bruce will be mentored by Chelsea Reed and Jessica will have Sara Parsons as her mentor. Second year teachers will have a mentor as well. Estimated numbers for enrollment showed an increase for elementary and a decrease for middle and high school.
- d. Secondary Lease from Unit Petroleum. Tabled until more information is received from lawyer Gordon Stull.
