CAPITAL RESERVE PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Education of the Roxbury Central School District be authorized to undertake a capital improvement project, consisting of the reconstruction and renovation of, and the construction of improvements, additions and upgrades to various District buildings and facilities and the sites thereof, all to include site, access, parking, athletic field and playfield improvements, demolition, asbestos abatement, utility, mechanical, plumbing and electrical improvements as well as payment of professional fees and all other necessary costs incidental to such work (the "Project") at a maximum estimated cost not to exceed \$950,000 and pay for the Project by expending available monies, including \$950,000 from the District's Capital Reserve Fund initially approved by the District's voters in May of 2019?"

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that qualified voters of the District may obtain applications for an absentee ballot from the office of the Clerk of the District. Completed applications must be received by the Clerk of the District no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 6, 2022, and must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on March 31, 2022 if the absentee ballot is to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4:00 p.m. on March 31, 2022 will require the voter to personally appear at the office of the Clerk of the District to receive an absentee ballot. A listing of all persons to whom an absentee ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter in the office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. during each of the 5 days prior to the election, except Sundays, and shall also be posted at the polling place at the election. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that military ballots may be applied for by qualified voters by requesting an application from the District Clerk at 607-326-4151 schorm@roxburycsd.org. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 13, 2022. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the

application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail. An individual will qualify as a military voter if he or she (1) is a qualified voter of the State of New York, who is in actual military service, and by reason of such military service is absent from the District on the day of the election, or is a voter who is discharged from military service within 30 days of an election; or (2) a spouse, parent, child, or dependent of such service member who is a qualified voter and is absent due to accompanying or being with the military service member.
