- 2. Parents must bring proof of residency (see reverse for required documents for proof of residency);
- 3. Lunch and textbook assistance applications are available on line (www.whiting.k12.in.us)
- 4. Payment of textbook fees and update student information;
- 5. Parents must bring current medical records and proof of immunizations;
- 6. All notarized forms must be signed by an Indiana Notary.
- 7. All forms should be completed before registration and are available at: www.whiting.k12.in.us

ON LINE REGISTRATION FOR CURRENT RETURN STUDENTS – ONLY Dates for on-line registration are: Wednesday, July 13th through Friday, July 22nd only if your child attended school last year and if you or your child has an assigned Parent Access Code. PROOF OF RESIDENCY

- 1. All Parents MUST bring in proof of residency.
- 2. Acceptable proof of residency includes the following:
- a) Proof of home ownership/rental/other housing arrangement.
- 3. If your address <u>has not changed</u>, bring in a current utility bill: A utility bill is considered current for the months of June, July, and August of 2022.
- 4. If your address <u>has changed</u>, bring in proof of ownership through mortgage papers, property tax receipt, closing statement, or deed; or, if renting, bring proof of rental (must provide Form #1 of enrollment packet). All notarized forms must be notarized by an Indiana Notary.
- 5. If the family is living with relatives or other persons, an affidavit –attesting that the family is residing at the Whiting address—will be required from the person with whom the family is living (Forms #1 and form #2 of the enrollment packet). All notarized forms must be notarized by an Indiana Notary.
- **6.** <u>Health Forms</u>: Health forms will be available online to be completed by the parents. The health form and a copy of the immunization record will need to be presented to the school staff at the time of the registration. Arrangements will be made for students with chronic health issues to see the nurse.
- 7. <u>Lunch/Textbook Assistance Applications</u>: These applications will be available online to be completed by the parents and returned to the school for processing. Parents must provide proof of income).
