List work history, length of employment at each position and number of hours worked.

Character: Write a 200 word or less description of yourself including your goals and values and three of the following attributes that may apply to you: integrity, honesty, trustworthiness, respectfulness, commitment and/or other characteristics.

Interview: Because we are unable to interview each applicant individually, we ask that each applicant answer a short questionnaire so we are able to get to know you a little better.

All applications must be submitted to: Stanley County School Guidance Counselor, by April 15, 2022.
