## Mandatory Supplies

- Change of clothes to be kept in the classroom all year in a gallon Zip-Loc bag **labeled with child's name**
  - Make sure to send in clothes for hot AND cold weather. (ex. T-shirt, sweatpants/leggings AND shorts, socks, underwear)

## Optional Supplies

- 1 pair of Velcro shoes to be kept at school
- 1 set of good quality headphones **labeled with child's name—no earbuds**
- Standard-size backpack with two shoulder straps, no wheels or drawstrings **labeled with child's name**
