WHAT IS THE PEER MODEL EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM?

Children without identified disabilities who reside in Northampton County and turn 3 by September 30 can participate in the Peer Model Early Childhood Program. This program is designed to support general education experiences for younger students with disabilities.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Children residing in Northampton County who will be 3 years old by September 30 and must demonstrate developmentally appropriate speech, language, social skills, and behaviors. Peer Models must be able to communicate clearly, interact well with others, model cooperative interactions and follow directions.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Free Program offering face to face instruction five days per week. Program hours are 8:00 am to 1:00 pm
- Must be a resident of Northampton County.
- Programs are located at Kiptopeke and Occohannock Elementary Schools.
- Daily attendance is required in accordance with division wide attendance policies.

• Peer models must complete a face-to-face trial day observation as part of the selection process.

• Transportation and meals are provided.
