Session 1 AM or PM: June 1 - June 23 (no Friday classes EXCEPT Fri. 6/3)
Session 2 AM (Math only): June 27 - July 21 (no Friday classes OR Mon. 7/4)

Attendance: Attendance is critical and mandatory. Students <u>may not miss more than 2 days of class</u>. If additional days are missed, the student will be dropped from the class with a withdrawal, resulting in an F on the MCHS transcript.

COST:

Due to Covid-19 and added challenges families may be facing, there will be no initial fee for Fresh Start. Students who are dropped from the class due to non-attendance will be assessed a \$25 fee.
