Little Miss and Mister Kitten Rules and Qualifications

- 1. To be eligible to compete in the Little Miss/Mister Kitten Pageant, contestants must be enrolled in Pre- Kindergarten to 5th grade at Van Vleck Elementary School and be in good academic and disciplinary standing.
- 2. Contestant application must be completed and submitted with a \$30 fee to the drop-off location by the deadline.
- 3. Contestants must sit for the scheduled photo session for the headshot to be included in the program.
- 4. Contestants and a parent/guardian must attend the pageant rehearsals and events.
- 5. For the pageant, Little Miss contestants should wear a nice dress at least knee length with dress shoes.
- 6. For the pageant, Little Mister contestants should wear pants, a button-up shirt, and dress shoes. Coat and tie are optional.
- 7. Parents/guardians should drop off their contestants fully dressed and ready for the pageant by 6:00PM on the day of the pageant.
- 8. Contestants must be picked up in the auditorium after the conclusion of their competition. Winners will need to stay at the pageant for a winner's photo that will be taken at the conclusion of the pageant.
- Contestants will NOT receive reimbursement for costs incurred for clothing, transportation, etc. This is the responsibility of the contestant's parents/guardians.
- 10. The Little Miss and Mister must be available to attend any and all community events and/or parades that the Van Vleck ISD deems necessary. He/she should have their own transportation to and from these events. The winners are invited to attend next year's photo day to be included in that program. Winners will also be expected to attend the following year's pageant to help pass on their title to the next winner.

Junior Miss and Mister Leopard Van Vleck Rules and Qualifications

- 1. To be eligible to compete in the Miss/Mister Leopard Pageant, contestants must be enrolled in 6th-8 th grade at Van Vleck Junior High and be in good academic and disciplinary standing.
- 2. Contestant application must be completed and submitted with a \$40 fee to the drop-off location by the deadline.
- 3. Contestants must sit for the scheduled photo session for the headshot to be included in the pageant program and the Most Photogenic part of the pageant.
- 4. Contestants must attend all pageant meetings, rehearsals, and the tea.
- 5. Contestants must dress in the same business attire for the tea/interview and part of the on-stage events. All business attire should look professional and appropriate. No short skirts, no strapless tops unless worn under a jacket, no open backs, no crop tops, no low cut tops.
- 6. Female Contestants are to select a party-length, tea-length or full-length gown for the dress for the pageant. Male Contestants should wear dress pants, a button-up shirt, and dress shoes. Coat and tie are optional.
- 7. Contestants may schedule with a salon of their choice to get hair, makeup and nails done. Van Vleck StuCo isn't financially responsible for any salon services provided.
- 8. Contestants will NOT receive reimbursement for costs incurred for clothing, hair styling, or transportation. This is the sole responsibility of the contestant.

 - c. Solid or small patterned prints that do not distract from viewing the contestant
 - d. Hair should be out of the eyes
 - e. No see-through fabrics unless layered with an appropriate undershirt
 - f. Appropriate length for pants or skirts is required
