

What is the Journeys 21st CCLC Program?

The Journeys After-School and Summer Programs are 21st Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) federally funded programs serving students enrolled in Winfield City Schools in grades Kindergarten through 8th grade.

- * There are no fees to attend the 21st CCLC K-8 program. *Pre-K is not a 21st CCLC grant funded program currently and will require a tuition fee. Hopefully it will be funded soon!*
- * A completed registration form packet is required to enroll. Contact Amanda Frost, Site Coordinator, at (205) 487-4988 or afrost@winfield.k12.al.us to enroll.
- * The Journeys After-School and Summer Program has a limit to the number of children enrolled. If the program is at capacity at the time of registration, your child will be placed on a waiting list. You will be contacted as soon as there is an opening.

Journeys 21st CCLC After-School Program

The Journeys After-School Program operates on the same schedule as Winfield City Schools. Hours of operation are from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. M – F when school is in session. Each day's program schedule includes supervised homework time, snacks, supervised play time, and other special activities such as arts & crafts, music, dance, Snap-Ed, and robotics. After school snack and an evening meal is offered at no additional cost. Students will participate in STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) activities. An afternoon snack will be provided.
