STUDENT USE OF VEHICLES: PARKING PERMITS

Students entering grade twelve may be authorized by the superintendent to drive a private vehicle to and from school. Only students who have received parent/guardian written permission and are issued a parking permit to park their vehicle in an assigned parking space during school hours shall be permitted to drive their vehicle to school.

The following rules shall apply to any student issued a parking permit and authorized to drive to and from school:

- A. The student shall submit written documentation that the automobile is registered and inspected by the State of New Jersey and properly insured;
- B. No student may operate or park an automobile on school premises during the school day without a parking permit;
- C. Automobiles shall not at any time be parked or left standing in fire zones, handicapped parking spots (unless authorized by the Department of Motor Vehicles) or in areas designated for staff and visitor parking;
- D. Permission for the use of an automobile is granted only for travel to and from school. The use of the automobile by students participating in field trips, sports events, and performances is prohibited;
- E. Once parked, an automobile may be visited during the school day only with the permission of the principal;
- F. Driving on school grounds must not exceed five miles per hour. Automobiles must be driven with caution and consideration to pedestrians and other vehicles at all times.
