Social-Emotional Transition for 6th Grade



- New, larger school = new faces
- Social changes/conflict
- Desire for independence
- Executive functioning challenges
- Hormonal changes
- Peer pressure ("FOMO")



Social Media and Pre-Teens

- Social media in the hands of adolescents may contribute to negative self-image, feelings of isolation or being left out (FOMO)
- Commonly used apps below require a user to be age 13 or older
- A "joint account" or monitoring your child's account <u>does not</u> prevent your children from being exposed to content that is inappropriate for their age and social development
- Claims of social media harassment, bullying, etc. can be challenging to investigate when the offender is unclear or unknown






