Students are required to take a fine arts class for one year in junior high. If a student wishes to continue with fine arts classes in 7th and 8th grade, it will count as one of their elective credits.

Students who wish to participate in sports in 7th and 8th grade will have athletics as one of their elective credits.
*In 7th \& 8th grade, or once the PE credit requirement is met, each year of athletics counts as 1 elective or 1 PE credit. Students who are in athletics will participate in off-season when their sport is over.
