I am here tonight to talk about choices.

The vaccine and mask mandates that are being issued are of great concern to me, the faculty, staff, and parents.

I put many hours into gathering information around these concerns. The fact of the matter is that there is a lot of conflicting information from various reputable sources.

On any day, you can read an article that states masks help with stopping the spread of covid.

On that same day, you can read from other reputable people that masks don't work and are ineffective.

There are studies have been conducted in schools with masks and schools without masks that conclude that there is no discernable difference in the results.

Is it any wonder that people are confused?

Did anyone watch the college games this weekend? Have you been to a concert?

Very few masks are at either.

Go to a restaurant- take your mask off when you are seated.

Go on a plane? Cruising height - have a drink and a snack.

Is there confusion? Yes

Is there room for questioning? Absolutely

I believe the solution is choice- let the parents decide if they want their kids to wear the mask or not.

I believe this is a decision that parents should have the ability to make based on what their beliefs are and what they think is best for their kids.
