#### C.1. Administration

Dr. Andrees asked the Board to approve several resignations and new hires tonight. Some of the reasons for resignations are stated below:

- Many of our teachers who have resigned receive more money elsewhere.
- Many districts are recruiting minorities and they have taken our experienced and talented teachers. They are going primarily to New Haven, Wallingford, Stratford and Bridgeport.

Dr. Andrees stated that we are excited to bring you many of the new staff which we have found to replace our losses. We are bringing some teachers in at higher salaries in our shortage areas.

We have both Haley and Washington who we are cited as needing more bilingual support. With the hiring of literacy teachers we are looking at bilingual staff to address both needs since we have not budgeted for additional elementary teachers.

After our last interviews today we have two positions left to fill:

1 Math

1 Speech Therapist

We are prepared to open school almost fully staffed.

We had an excellent week of new teacher training and professional learning for many of our staff has been carried out throughout the summer.

UNH science training for elementary teachers

Culturally Response Classrooms for Elementary, Middle and the High School
