## 22-23 Pre-School Screenings

#### **Graduation Rates**

Oxford has worked diligently to help students meet requirements to graduate from high school. For 20-21 OHS had a 96.7% graduation rate. The state average was 88.1%. The rate includes any student who entered Oxford High School or virtual school from their freshman year until the graduation year. If a student leaves OHS or OVS and decides to homeschool or not enroll in another district prior to their cohort's graduation year, the student counts as a dropout.

## **Oxford Math State Assessment Performance**

USD 358 adopted the Ready Math curriculum for grades K-8 starting in the 18-19 school year. Last spring, all but two grade levels exceeded the state performance averages in Math. 58% percent of 3rd graders scored in levels 3 or 4 (top two levels), the state average was 46%. 7th Graders scored 30.43% in levels 3 or 4 with the state average 20.17%.

## Oxford/Geuda Springs Road Closure

Oxford Road just south of Oxford to 140th Street South will be closed to through traffic beginning April 4 until the road is completed (likely October). Students and parents should start planning for a different route to school. Bus routes will also be modified.
