Team placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in State with 4 athletes earning state medals.




#### Counselor's Corner

There are grants such as Pell Grants, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (FSEOG), Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grants. Also, scholarships, work-study jobs, and loans. Scholarships are sometimes based on merit and/or areas of study. Work study allows you to earn money to pay for school by working part-time.
