## Things to Know

## WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

### Math

- In math this week we are continuing to work on our geometry unit. We are going to be learning about 3-D shapes, naming them and matching them to their two-dimensional net.

### Science

- This week in science we will spend time doing some fun activities with ecosystems and wrap up all of our learning about ecosystems.

### Social Studies:

- We will be reviewing economics and how the geographic characteristics influence the economy of countries and regions around the world.

### Reading/Writing

- We are continuing our Literary Essay Unit/ Text-Dependent Analysis unit. Students will be reading and writing about their reading by making claims. We are working with the students to put their thoughts and opinions about the text into their writing and use evidence from their book.
