- Applicant must electronically submit the "general information" on page 2 along with an essay.
- Essay can be provided in any of the following formats: PDF, MS Word document, or scanned document. Essay should be 1-2 typed pages explaining your plans and goals after graduating from high school, how the scholarship will help you reach those goals and why you think you should be granted this scholarship. Essays will be judged on proper spelling, punctuation, format and quality of content.
- Teacher Recommendation - see attached. It is the applicant's responsibility to follow up with your teacher to make sure it has been submitted before the deadline.
- Applicant must contact the proper school official to request his/her transcript is electronically submitted to the email addresses below no later than April 29th.
- The high school transcript should reflect the student's standing (class rank and GPA) through December 2021.
- Applicant must contact college to request a college transcript if dual credit courses have been completed, to be electronically submitted to the addresses below no later than April $29^{\text {th }}$. Transcripts can be requested from the WTC Transcript Office at: transcript@wtc.edu.
