The Child Advocacy Center of Northeast Missouri will be presenting a Sexual Abuse Prevention program at your child's school. This program is age appropriate. Students will gain an understanding of what sexual abuse is and ways to protect themselves in-person and online. The program encourages students to talk/report to a safe trusted adult if they witness or experience sexual abuse, and to utilize available resources for support. Missouri State Statute 170.045 requires school districts to provide this training each year to every student in grades 6th -12th.
