Dear Graduate 2022 Parent:

Congratulations to you and your graduate on his/her graduation. I have visited with seniors several times in the last few weeks regarding information they will need as they prepare for college, military or careers in the work place. Hopefully they have shared all that information with you, but in case they haven't I would like to share it with you as well. Upon returning their sash after graduation each graduate will receive a large manila envelope containing their diploma as well as other important documents and information.

If your student has taken dual credit courses through Truman University, Central Methodist University, Ozark Technical College, or Missouri State University, it is his/her responsibility to request college transcripts be sent to his/her prospective university. There is a nominal fee involved. This is done electronically and there is a document with contact information and web address provided in the graduation envelope. If students have taken classes through our Ag or FACS classes, those teachers will have the information your student needs to access those transcripts. Please understand high school transcripts reflect credits as high school credits only. It is important for your student to know which classes he/she has taken for dual credit when they visit their prospective campus to enroll in classes in order to assure they aren't enrolled in classes for which they have already earned college credit.


Also included in the graduation envelope is a copy of your student's immunization record as well as a letter from Ms. Fredrick advising when future immunization will be necessary. Please understand that these records are relevant not only in the near future, but for several years to come.

For those students lucky enough to have earned a local scholarship, the information necessary to access his/her scholarship was provided on the back of the scholarship certificate on the evening of Senior Awards. Please encourage your student to write a thank you note at least a few days before attempting to collect the scholarship award. If your student has received a scholarship from outside our school community, contact information should have been included with the scholarship announcement. If you do not have that information, feel free to contact either myself or Linda Krattli.

Finally, we have collected information from all seniors who need to have final transcripts sent to his/her prospective school on the green paper, end of year "Senior Form". Those transcripts will be sent shortly after transcripts are certified in the first week of June. In the meantime, your student's school of choice will probably continue to send automated electronic messages stating final transcripts have not been received. Don't panic. They will be sent as soon as possible. Once transcripts are received at a given school, it may take as long as two weeks for them to be processed.

Working with the students of the Class of 2022 has been a pleasure. Thank you for the privilege.

## DUAL CREDIT COURSES TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION:

Courses taken in high school for both high school and college credit may be counted toward satisfying the core curricular requirements. You must be a Junior or Senior to take these dual credit courses for college credit and **maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.00 or higher**. In addition, it is recommended that students make a "B" or higher in the prerequisite courses. Some additional requirements may be imposed by the State of Missouri or the University issuing credit. MCHS dual credit courses are:
