





School Health Requirements

PRESCHOOL

- Current <u>Kentucky Immunization Certificate</u> must be on file at all times (additional immunization required at age
 4). If Immunizations are declined, an <u>Immunization Declination Form</u> must be signed, notarized (with notary stamp)
- Proof of a physical exam completed on a <u>Kentucky Preventative Health Care Examination Form</u>
- An Eye exam completed by an ophthalmologist or optometrist, submitted on the <u>Kentucky Vision Examination</u>
 Form
- Proof of a dental screening/exam conducted by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician, registered nurse, nurse
 practitioner, or physician assistant. The screening/exam must be on the <u>Kentucky Dental/Examination Form</u>

KINDERGARTEN

- A current <u>Kentucky Immunization Certificate</u> must be on file at all times. If Immunizations are declined, an <u>Immunization Declination Form must be signed</u>, notarized (with notary stamp).
- Proof of a physical exam completed on a <u>Kentucky Preventative Health Care Examination Form</u>**
- An Eye exam completed by an ophthalmologist or optometrist, submitted on the <u>Kentucky Vision Examination</u>
 Form**
- Proof of a dental screening/exam conducted by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician, registered nurse, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant. The screening/exam must be on the <u>Kentucky Dental/Examination Form</u>
- ** Indicates the form is not required if previously submitted in Paducah Public Preschool (HeadStart)

GRADES 1-5

- A current <u>Kentucky Immunization Certificate</u> must be on file at all times. If Immunizations are declined, an <u>Immunization Declination Form</u> must be signed, notarized (with notary stamp).
- An Eye exam completed by an ophthalmologist or optometrist, submitted on the <u>Kentucky Vision Examination</u> Form (ages 5 & 6 only, if not previously submitted in preschool or Kindergarten)
- Proof of a dental screening/exam conducted by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician, registered nurse, nurse
 practitioner, or physician assistant. The screening/exam must be on the <u>Kentucky Dental/Examination Form</u>
 (ages 5 & 6 only, if not previously submitted in preschool or Kindergarten)

GRADE 6

- A current <u>Kentucky Immunization Certificate</u> must be on file at all times. <u>Additional immunizations are required</u> at age 11-12. If Immunizations are declined, an <u>Immunization Declination Form</u> must be signed, notarized (with notary stamp).
- Proof of a physical exam completed on a <u>Kentucky Preventative Health Care Examination Form</u> (may be conducted up to 1 year prior to 6th grade entry)

GRADES 7-12

A current <u>Kentucky Immunization Certificate</u> must be on file at all times. <u>Additional immunizations are required</u>
 at age 16. If Immunizations are declined, an <u>Immunization Declination Form</u> must be signed, notarized (with notary stamp).
