- Encourage your child to dress comfortably on testing days, work to their highest ability and persevere.
- Make sure that your child arrives at school on time so that any preparations or instructions will not be missed.
- Encourage your child to have a confident and positive attitude about the testing. Please do not over-stress the importance of test results; students who are tense often do not perform at their true ability level.

The PSSA results provide our school with an objective measure of our educational program. In addition to district-based assessments, the PSSA also assists you in gaining a better understanding of your child's ability and performance based on state standards.
