- Improvements to Parking Lots, Bus Lane and Courtyards
- Expansion of CES Gym/Cafeteria Foyer Area
- Improvements to Fencing

### District Quick Facts

- Coahoma ISD serves approximately 1000 students in PreK – 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Enrollment at CISD has increased over 200 students, or 25%, in the past five years.
- Coahoma ISD earned a 2017 state accountability rating of Met Standard.
- Coahoma ISD earned a 2016 Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas (FIRST) rating of Superior.

### Estimated Tax Impact

The chart below shows the estimated tax impact based on current taxable values for the district.

Appraised Home Value	Monthly Impact	Annual Impact
\$100,000	\$7.50	\$90.00
\$150,000	\$11.25	\$135.00
\$250,000	\$18.75	\$225.00

If you are over the age of 65 or disabled, your home property taxes will not increase if you have been granted the "Over 65" or "disabled" homestead exemption. This tax freeze is on the homestead only, and may be adjusted up if major renovations are done to the property after the exemption is granted.
